**CURRICULUM.** Candidates for the Master of Science in Data Science are required to complete a minimum of 30 credits, including 21 credits of required/core courses and 9 credits of electives. This program may be pursued part-time or full-time.

### Data Science Courses | Data Science Institute

Master of Science: The M.S. program requires 30 credits to be completed part-time (less than 12 credits per semester) or full-time (12 or more credits per semester). All degree requirements must be completed within five years of the beginning of graduate study.
