In North America, Europe, and Asia, an environmental risk assessment (ERA) is required to evaluate (see Chapter 13) the impacts of pharmaceuticals, in particular, entering the environment as part of the drug approval process (EMA, 2006; FDA, 1998). Results of various widely accepted test methodologies (laid down mainly by the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, OECD) form the basis of the risk assessment process.

The general principles for assessing environmental health risks are described below. Risk assessment determines whether a health hazard poses an actual health risk at the identified level of exposure, the nature of the said health risk, and the risk management measures that should be taken.
