What is a forest? Forests are rich abundant habitats full of trees and shrubs and all kinds of animals. Before people arrived in New Zealand, 80% of the land was covered in dense forest. Now only 24% of land is native forest, or just under 6.5 million hectares. Two of the main types of native forest in New Zealand are beech and podocarp-hardwood.

Temperate Forest Habitat - Kids

Mixed PineHardwood Forest. The hardwood and mixed pine habitat type occurs on 21,377 acres of the refuge's 153,017 acres and is found in scattered areas throughout the refuge. Red maple, red bay, and black gum are dominant hardwood trees with an average height of 50 to 60 feet.

Habitat Types - Alligator River - U.S. Fish and Wildlife ...

The main layers of all forest types are the forest floor, the understorey and the canopy. The emergent layer exists in tropical rainforests. Each layer has a different set of plants and animals depending upon the availability of sunlight, moisture and food. Forest floor contains decomposing leaves, animal droppings, and dead trees.
