The possession limit is two days bag limit (see images below and FAQ).

The rivers that flow into the eastern Gulf of Mexico historically supported 58 species of freshwater mussels. Nearly 70% are endemic to (found only in) these systems. Seventeen listed mussels and 6 at risk mussels occur in river basins from the Escambia River east to the Suwannee River. Habitat loss and degradation as a result of impoundments, pollution, sedimentation, channel dredging, altered flow regimes, and development activities are

the primary reason for their decline.
