Precede page numbers for newspaper articles with p. or pp. If an article appears on discontinuous pages, give all page numbers, and separate the numbers with a comma (e.g., pp. B1, B3, B5-B7). Example (electronic version):

To cite a newspaper article in MLA format, start by writing the author's last and first name, separated by a comma. Next, add the title of the article, ending with a period, and put the entire title in quotation marks. Then, include the name of the newspaper in italics and place a comma after it.

If you found a newspaper article through an online database (e.g., EBSCO's Academic Search Complete), you do not need to include that information in the citation, either. If a URL runs across multiple lines of text in the citation, break the URL off before punctuation (e.g., periods, forward slashes) - except http://.

Add a period after the closing parenthesis. Add the name of the newspaper in italics, followed by a comma. Add the abbreviation "p." or "pp." and the page numbers.

Newspaper articles are cited much like other periodical sources in APA style, with the specific publication date included if available, and the name of the newspaper written in italics. Print newspaper citations include a page number or range; online newspaper citations include a URL.

To cite an online newspaper article in a reference entry in MLA style 8th edition include the following elements: Author(s) name: Give the last name and name as presented in the source (e. g. Watson, John). For two authors, reverse only the first name, followed by 'and' and the second name in normal order (e. g. Watson, John, and John Watson).
