Pry the CV axle from the transaxle, using a large pry bar. There is a ring clip holding it inside the transaxle that needs to be dislodged. Remove the CV axle once the ring clip releases. Some transaxle fluid will leak out. Be sure to top off the fluid in the differential after replacing the CV axle.

Refasten the assemblies in the order you removed them. Starting with the hub assembly to the strut tower, refasten all of the bolts you removed. Reconnect the outer tie rod to the steering knuckle next, and then reattach the caliper. Any old cotter pins may be brittle, so you should replace them with new ones rather than reusing the old pins.

Pour In New T-IV ATF. Poured In 3 U.S. Quarts. Insert a small automotive funnel in to the transmission dipstick hole. The owner's manual for the 2005 Toyota Corolla S states that the automatic transaxle's fluid capacity for a drain and refill is 3.2 U.S. quarts (3.0 Liters or 2.6 Imperial Quarts).

Position a drain pan under the transmission drain plug. Remove the fill plug using a 24mm socket wrench. Remove the drain plug using a 24mm socket wrench allowing the fluid to drain out. Replace the crush washer on the drain plug and tighten it to 29 lb-ft.

Remove the Axle Shaft From the Transmission Differential Rotate the axle shaft until one of the lips or ears on the CV bearing cup is pointing up. The transmission must be in neutral to rotate the shaft. After positioning the bearing cup, place the transmission back into "park" to prevent the shaft from moving.

The color may eventually appear light brown. A dark brown color with a burnt odor may indicate fluid deterioration and signal a need for a transaxle fluid change. TRANSAXLE FLUID CHECKING PROCEDURE: 1. Start engine and drive vehicle until the transaxle reaches operating temperature of 82-93 degrees C (180-200 degrees F).
