Using a set of cutting pliers, cut off the clear clips. The only thing holding the blue OEM connector to the speaker now is an adhesive. Work a flathead screwdriver between the blue connector and OEM speaker, breaking the adhesive bond and fully separating the two. Using the cutting pliers, cut the two wires as close to the OEM speaker as possible.

Locate your factory-mounted speakers - Most speakers are located behind panels to prevent damage and to cover them up, blending them into their surroundings. They will be covered with a grille, most commonly plastic with dotted holes through. Tip: Always replace speakers in pairs for the best clarity and sound from side to side.

### How to Install a New Pair of Car Speakers | YourMechanic ...

Running aftermarket 4 ohm speakers with the 2 ohm JBL amp will significantly decrease the volume output. Also the signal going to the front door speakers is split into just bass for the main door subwoofer speaker and separate signal for the tweeter with the JBL amp.
