Both the Modern Language Association (MLA) style and the American Psychological Association (APA) style require similar formats when you use a newspaper name in an essay. Capitalize the first word and all other important words (more than three letters long) of the newspaper name in the essay. Type the newspaper name in italics.

The Secret to Writing Great Headlines for News Stories

Italicize the name of the newspaper in which the article was printed, and type a comma, followed by "pp," followed by the section and page number on which the article ran. Type the last name, then the full first name of the author of the newspaper article (for MLA style). Type the full name of the newspaper article in quotes, followed by a period.

Use an apostrophe to indicate possession. If the noun is singular, such as girl or dog, put an apostrophe after the last letter and add an s (dog's ball)—even if the singular noun ends in s (James's car). Add an apostrophe after the s if the noun is plural and ends in s, and do not add another s (girls' ribbons).
