Event safety - Health and safety topics

Danger - To alert people to a danger (which is used when there is an immediate risk), OSHA says signs and other safety signals should be red or predominantly red. Any lettering or symbols need to be a contrasting color to ensure maximum visibility. Warning - The warning category is for when there is a risk, but it is not as severe or immediate as when danger is used.
