Are you wondering what you need to do to get a 7 in IB Psychology? It's a bit tough to say exactly because as of now (February 2019) we have not had any exams for this new curriculum. But as I'm marking my students' mock exams I have also created the grade boundaries that I will use for IB Psychology until the IB releases theirs.

IB Psychology - Grade Boundaries New Curriculum (Feb 2019)

Your ability to write effective essay questions is tested to the limit in each of the three IB Psychology exams: Paper 1 requires you to answer one ERQ and three SAQs, thus half your marks are weighted on your sole essay answer. Paper 2 is only assessed through ERQs.

Paper 2 – Options – (SL – 1 hour, HL – 2 hours) The assessment for Paper 2 is a one-hour ERQ from a choice of 3 prompts for each of the options below. SL students answer one option (so the paper is one hour) while HL students will answer 2 options and thus take 2 hours. Like Paper 1, each ERQ response is worth 22 marks and is assessed using the same rubric.
