Invocations of the Shadhili Order - Wardah Books

The Shadhili order takes its name from Shaykh Abu'l-Hassan ash-Shadhili (1196/1197 - 1258 CE). He was born in Ghumara, near Cueta in northern Morocco into a family of peasant labourers. He studied the principles of Islamic Law (fiqh) at the Qarawiyyin University in Fez. He subsequently traveled to many countries.

The Shadhili Tariqa (Arabic: تڤردا شادھللي ءف ءفردا شادھللي) is a Sufi order of Sunni Islam founded by Abul Hasan Ali ash-Shadhili of Morocco in the 13th century. Followers (Arabic murids, "seekers") of the Shadhiliya are known as Shadhilis.. It has historically been of importance and influence in North Africa and Egypt with many contributions to Islamic literature.
