### Documentation required when applying for a visa to visit ...

An Irish visa will be placed into a blank page of your passport/travel document. Your passport/travel document and certain original documents (eg marriage/birth/death certificates and other documents listed by you) will be returned to you by post or arranged for collection at an international Visa Office, Irish Embassy or Consulate.

### Long Stay Visas (More than 3 months) - INIS

Requirements. Whether you need a visa to enter Ireland depends on what country you're from, see Schedule 1. S.I. No 473 of 2014 groups countries into five different categories (schedules). Note: A Schengen visa or UK visa is not valid for travel to Ireland.For exceptions to this, please see Schedules 2 and 3 below.

Applicants should be aware: By law, those travelling to Ireland will be required to fill out a form called the ' Covid-19 Passenger Locator Form'. This form, which can be completed before you travel, may be used by Irish health authorities to contact you to verify your location in Ireland.

All supporting documents must be original documents and in English, or accompanied by a notarised translation. For guidance on the supporting documents that you may wish to consider submitting as part of your application please refer to the website of the Irish Naturalisation and Immigration Service.

The supporting document can be the visa or residence permit from Schengen Area (Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland) or from US, UK and Ireland.

### What is the supporting document (visa/residence permit ...

You can apply for a study visa up to three months before your date of arrival to Ireland. To apply, you must simply complete an online application form on the website of the Irish Naturalization and Immigration Service. After filling the online application process, follow the instructions and submit your supporting documentation.
