ISO 19005 PDF/A is an ISO -standardized version of the Portable Document Format (PDF) specialized for use in the archiving and long-term preservation of electronic documents. PDF/A differs from PDF by prohibiting features unsuitable for long-term archiving, such as font linking (as opposed to font embedding) and encryption.

The PDF/A-1 standard defines two levels of conformance: conformance level A (known as PDF/A-1a) satisfies all requirements in the specification; level B (known as PDF/A-1b) is a lower level of conformance, "encompassing the requirements of this part of ISO 19005 regarding the visual appearance of electronic documents, but not their structural or semantic properties."

Converting a file to PDF/A-1a compliant or Font-embedded versions. PDF/A is an archival format of PDF that embeds all fonts used in the document within the PDF file, meaning that a user of you file will not have to have the same fonts that you used to create the file installed on their computer in order to read it. Some of the
