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### Literary Response Paper

A literary response paper writing is a response to the specific literary you have just read. It is your own understanding and knowledge that you have gained from the specific reading. While it is a summary of the reading, you also need to emphasize the main topics, themes, and ideas presented to you.

A literary response paper builds an argument about a text, using evidence to explain how the author uses characters, symbols, or other literary strategies to convey a message. The typical length is 2-3 pages (typed, double-spaced; with a minimum of 5 paragraphs), but it can be longer.
