Moreover, differences between applied and basic research can be summarized into three points: 1.

Typical methods of data collection used in applied research include desk research to review existing data (statistical databases, various records, research articles or books, etc.), observations of the target population or a process, surveys, various types of interviews, and, sometimes, focus groups.
