Nutrition support alone does not reverse or cure a disease or injury. It is adjunctive therapy that enables a patient to meet nutrient needs during curative or palliative therapy. Nutrition support via a feeding tube or intravenous catheter is a lifesaving therapy for patients who are unable to meet nutrient needs orally.

Nutrition Support at the End of Life: A Critical Decision

Severe malnutrition should prompt hospital admission for initiation of nutritional support (Grade D). The initiation and formulation of enteral (tube feeding) or parenteral nutrition should be guided by current clinical practice guidelines (Grade D).
