**Open Dental Software - User Settings**  
User ID: This is an internal unique identifier that is useful for third party reporting.. Domain User: Only visible if Domain Login (Single Sign on) is turned on.Click [...] and select the domain user. Name: Enter the employee's user name for logging on to Open Dental.. DoseSpot User ID: If this is a provider using DoseSpot eRx, enter the user ID assigned by DoseSpot.
