Normally the default (in XP) is set to 800x600 which means the display will be 800 pixels wide and 600 pixels high.

For Windows Vista and Windows XP. On the Screen Resolution window, move the Resolution slider to select 800 x 600 pixels or higher.

Set the resolution manually on XP - Windows Forum - Spiceworks

Click on the arrow next to the resolution that's currently set to see a drop-down of available options. Select the resolution that you believe best fits your needs. Note: Windows does its best to detect the optimal resolution for the monitor that's plugged in. The operating system marks this resolution as the "Recommended" option.

Click and drag the "Resolution" slider left or right. It's near the bottom of the "Display Settings" window. Dragging the slider to the left will decrease your screen resolution, while dragging it to the right will increase the resolution. Raising your resolution will make things smaller, while lowering the resolution will make things larger.

Select screen resolution presets After selecting your desired resolution, hit the Apply button. Windows will give you 15 seconds to check the new resolution. If it creates any issues, you can revert within the 15-second timeframe by clicking the Revert button.

3 Ways To Change Screen Resolution In Windows 10

You can reduce the resolution to enlarge the text, but then it just looks choppy and messy. If you modify the DPI scaling instead, you can maintain the crispness of the screen resolution while making things larger or smaller as you see fit. If you're using a flat-panel display for Windows Vista, the screen resolution is pretty much a given.
