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### Special Education Law

Special education law (IDEA) states that the assessment of your child must involve various tests and measures to determine whether your child has a disability. A school district must conduct an initial evaluation to determine if the student qualifies for special education within 60 days of receiving consent.

The federal government, under U.S. Code Title 20, Chapter 33, ensures rights to disabled students and their families through a law called the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). This act is the crux of special ed law, because it governs how states and public agencies provide early intervention, special education, and related services to children with disabilities.

## **An Overview of Special Ed Law - FindLaw**

IDEA is the collection of federal regulations for special education that ensures a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) for students with disabilities that attend public schools. IDEA requires that each public school provide services to eligible special education students in the least restrictive environment (LRE) and in accordance with each student's individualized education program (IEP).
