Although ventriculoperitoneal (VP) shunts do not have fewer complications than ventriculoatrial shunts, the complications are less severe and have a lower mortality rate.

Patients who have communicating hydrocephalus or who have failed an ETV may benefit from the placement of a ventriculoperitoneal shunt (VP Shunt). This device drains cerebrospinal fluid from the brain to the abdominal cavity with a thin silicone tube. A valve is used to control the amount of fluid drained.

A 65-year-old woman with hydrocephalus developed persistent lower abdominal pain radiating to the perineal area after shunt insertion. Radiography suggested that the distal end of a peritoneal catheter was located in a cul-de-sac of the pelvis.

If the shunt is infected, then externalization and antibiotic therapy is suggested. If no infection is present, many surgeons reposition the catheter by direct visualization. If there are fibrous adhesions or if there is concern about possible infectious sequelae, using a ventriculoopleural or ventriculovenous shunt is recommended.

Neurology - Abdominal Complications of VP Shunts

A shunt chamber that is slow to refill after compression indicates an obstruction of the peritoneal limb. When it is necessary to access the shunt for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes, it is best to use a noncoring needle, such as the Huber needle or an 18-gauge Chiba needle with the stylet in place.

Percutaneous Placement and Management of the Denver Shunt ...

A guide wire was advanced through the needle, and the commercially available gastrostomy tube was placed over the wire from the aerodigestive tract, through the stomach, to the abdominal wall. In each patient with a pre-existing VP shunt, the shunt tract was carefully demarcated so it could be avoided during PEG tube placement.
