The shin hanga movement included several artists, each known for their favourite subject: Hashiguchi Goyo for his portraits of women, Ito Shinsui for his portraits of women and landscapes, Yamamura Koka and Ohta Masamitsu for their portraits of Kabuki actors, Ohara Koson for his prints of birds and Kawase Hasui and Hiroshi Yoshida for their landscapes. Kawase Hasui and Hiroshi Yoshida probably have been the two most popular shing hanga artists who focused on urban or rural landscapes.
