Treatment often involves a team of health care practitioners, including a nutritionist, who may provide specific meal plans or information about the calories needed to restore weight to a normal level. There are no specific drugs to treat anorexia nervosa. However, newer antipsychotic drugs, such as olanzapine, may help people gain weight.

Anorexia nervosa is an eating disorder characterized by restriction of energy intake and intense fear of gaining weight. For women, the lifetime prevalence of developing anorexia is between 1.2 and 2.2% (Smink et al, 2012).
