The upper gastrointestinal (GI) tract consists of the oral cavity, oesophagus, stomach, and the first part of the small intestine - the duodenum. Common conditions affecting the upper GI tract include dyspepsia, peptic ulcers, gastritis, cancer, gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) or heartburn, and will usually require prompt clinical care by a gastroenterologist or a colorectal surgeon.

Upper Digestive (Oesophagus & Stomach) Disorders

The esophagus is the tube through which food and liquid pass into the stomach. The walls of the esophagus propel food to the stomach by rhythmic waves of muscular contractions called peristalsis. The lower esophageal sphincter (or LES) is a muscle that separates the esophagus from the stomach. It acts like a valve that normally stays tightly closed to prevent contents in the stomach from backing ...

Doctors use endoscopy for a close-up view of the upper digestive tract—the esophagus, stomach, and the first part of the small intestine. Doctors use upper GI endoscopy—also known as esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD)—to diagnose a range of diseases and conditions.

For esophageal cancer, surgery may remove some or most of the esophagus through an esophagectomy. Sometimes the cancer has spread to the upper part of the stomach, and that must be removed as well. There are new minimally invasive forms of esophagectomy surgery now being performed.

Unfortunately, most esophageal cancers are not found early enough for doctors to cure them with surgery. Often a small part of the stomach is removed as well. The upper part of the esophagus is then connected to the remaining part of the stomach. Part of the stomach is pulled up into the chest or neck to become the new esophagus.

Upper GI series facts. An upper gastrointestinal series is an x-ray test used to define the anatomy of the upper digestive tract. Women who are or may be pregnant should notify the doctor requesting the procedure and the radiology staff. An upper gastrointestinal series involves filling the esophagus, stomach, and small intestines with a white liquid material (barium).

During a procedure known as a Nissen fundoplication, your surgeon wraps the upper part of your stomach around the lower esophagus. This enhances the anti-reflux barrier and can provide permanent relief for reflux. Your surgeon may perform this surgery laparoscopically, which means the procedure is less invasive and recovery is faster.

Stomach acid that returns, or "refluxes," back into the esophagus from the stomach can cause irritation and inflammation of the esophagus (esophagitis) that may lead to bleeding. Varices.

What causes bleeding in the esophagus?

Specializing in minimally invasive techniques, surgeons at the CADC may perform a subtotal or partial gastrectomy (removal of part of the stomach containing the cancer) or a total gastrectomy (removal of the entire stomach, connecting the esophagus to the small intestine).
