However, many current style manuals recommend italicizing book titles and magazine names (impossible to do on a typewriter) and using quotation marks around articles.

Book References - APA Style

If the book you're citing is a second or later edition (i.e. when the edition is stated on the title page or cover), specify this in your reference. Abbreviate 'edition' to 'edn' or 'revised edition' to 'rev ed'. When referencing a book published in multiple volumes, include the total number of volumes in your reference.

Referencing Books in Harvard Style | Templates & Examples

First, let's start by looking at the standard APA format for writing a book reference. The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, and publisher.

The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Your citation of a book in your reference list typically begins with the last name of the author of the book. After the last name, place a comma, and then type the first and middle initials of the author. Example: "Doe, J. H." If there are 2 authors, separate their names with an ampersand ("Doe, J. H. & Rowell, L. C.").

To cite a book in MLA, start by listing the author's last name followed by their first name, separated by a comma. Then, add a period at the end of their first name, and provide the title of the book in italics with a period at the end. Finally, include the name of the publisher and the publication date, separated by a comma.

If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. Always include the issue number for a journal article. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page). The reference in this case is the same as for a print journal article.

Journal Article References

References to books should include the following: The author (s), or editor (s) - by surname and initial (s) The title (in italics or bold) The edition other than the first (if applicable) The publisher's name. Year of publication. Edited publications.

After the year, list the title of the book in sentence case -- only capitalize the first word of the title and subtitle, if applicable, just as if you were writing a sentence. Italicize the title of the book; don't underline it or any other part of the citation. Finally, list the location, followed by a colon, and then the publisher.

Is a Book Title Underlined or Italicized When Typing in ...

The name, date and page reference of the work in which information originated should appear first, followed by 'cited' and then the name etc. of the work in which the information was found. Only the work you have read should appear in the reference list at the end of the work.
