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The IDSA/ATS CAP guidelines recommend that, in addition to clinical features, a diagnosis of pneumonia require demonstrable infiltrate by chest x-ray or other imaging technique, with or without microbiological data.

2019 IDSA Guidelines for Community Acquired Pneumonia in ...

The guidelines recommend different treatment regimens for patients with CAP depending on the treatment location (inpatient or outpatient), whether the pneumonia is classified as severe according to the criteria in TABLE 1, and whether the patient has comorbidities or any risk factors for drug-resistant pathogens.
