Edvard Hagerup Grieg was born in Bergen, Norway (then part of Sweden-Norway).His parents were Alexander Grieg (1806-1875), a merchant and the British Vice-Consul in Bergen; and Gesine Judithe Hagerup (1814-1875), a music teacher and daughter of solicitor and politician Edvard Hagerup. The family name, originally spelled Greig, is associated with the Scottish Clann Ghriogair (Clan Gregor).

From 1868, the coastal steamer went all year round, but Grieg only used it in spring.
