The clues in the pedigree have to be interpreted differently depending on whether one of the contrasting phenotypes is a rare disorder or whether both phenotypes of a pair are common morphs of a polymorphism. The genetic disorders of human beings can be dominant or recessive phenotypes and can be either autosomal or X-linked.

STUDYING PEDIGREES ACTIVITY

1. Do a complementation test... the strain with the unknown mutation is crossed with the known torso mutant strain or the fs strain. If the unknown mutation (called mut in the diagram below) is in torso, the progeny of the cross will also have the same phenotype (tailless offspring) -- i.e., the unknown mutation fails to complement torso and therefore the unknown mutation is in torso.
