The hull is the most visible part of a ship, because it is the body of the watercraft. The hull makes the ship buoyant while providing shelter to those on board, and is divided by bulkheads and decks, depending on its size. The most common faults are shown below. Vibrations in the cord, or drive, give a wavy indicator diagram, but a smooth draw diagram. The drum hits the stop at one of the end points, before the diagram is completed: The cord is too long or too short. The indicator piston works sluggishly in the cylinder, and moves in jerks: If only the expansion curve is wrong (wavy), the cause may be gas ...
